



Fire dampers are used in heating, ventilation and air conditioning ducts to prevent the spread of fire inside the ductwork in case of fire. Because smoke and toxic gases can be more dangerous than fire itself, it is important that the fire damper prevent smoke from spreading. Halton is the manufacturer of gas-tight fire dampers.

Keeping evacuation routes clear with Halton Active Smoke Control system

Halton Marine cabin ventilation system can be equipped with components and controls that combined with the vessel's fire alarm system act as an Active Smoke Control system. The key is the pressure relations between different sections and escape routes.

Blast dampers are designed for protection of ventilation systems against destructive blast forces. Halton offers several types of blast dampers for naval applications.

Keeping galley ducts grease free with Halton Marine UV-hoods
